Welcome to the Summer Term everyone! Hopefully you have all received your curriculum letters from your child's teacher outlining all the learning (and fun) that is planned for this term. Proposed Closure of Southwark Fire Station

As you may already be aware there are plans to close Southwark Fire Station, as well as New Cross and cuts at Peckham Fire Station. This will mean three less fire appliances available locally.

Public consultation on the cuts began on the 5th March 2013 and will continue until 17th June 2013. The London Fire Brigade have arranged for a series of public meetings to be held in each borough of London so that residents can have their views heard on these proposals.
