Europe

- The seven continents of the world are: Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America, South America.
- Europe is a continent in the Northern Hemisphere
- Europe is the 2nd smallest continent by size but the 3rd largest by population.
- The United Kingdom is a European country. It is separated from continental Europe by the English Channel.
- Europe is made up of 44 countries.

- continent:** one of the earth's seven major areas of land.
- capital city:** the main city of a country, where the government is located
- hemisphere:** half of the earth.
- climate:** the usual weather in a place.
- population:** the total number of people living in an area.
- topography:** the shape of the earth's surface across an area or region.
- agriculture:** farming.
- trade:** buying and selling goods.
- tourism:** travelling for fun and relaxation.
- grid reference:** a way of finding a position on a map; co-ordinates.
- key:** a guide to symbols on a map.
- compass:** a device showing direction.
