WhatsApp Community Guidelines

Do's

- Respect the ethos, vision and values of our school
- Treat all members of the school community with respect
- Keep in mind cultural sensitivity between all group members
- Communicate politely at all times
- Share and celebrate community events which may be of interest to others
- Don't be afraid to ask questions (no matter how silly they may seem)
- Remind each other of important school dates / events
- Offer support and reassurance when needed
- Direct group members to speak directly to the school, should an issue arise
- Remind group members of these guidelines if they are not being followed

Don'ts

- Use the group as a platform to discuss/air grievances regarding a staff member, child, parent or carer in the class or school
- Discuss the needs or behaviour of specific children at the school
- Use the group as a political platform for airing opinions on current affairs
- Raise grievances with other parents
- Use inappropriate/offensive language
