15 Hours Free Eligibility and Fees for 2 Year Old places

From the term, after their second birthday, some children are eligible for 15 hours of free Early Years education per week during term time. Parents of these children will be informed of their entitlement by their local authority. At Charles Dickens, we have a number of part time places reserved for those entitled to free provision. If you think you are entitled please provide the school with the relevant code. If you wish to have a full-time place, there is a top up cost of £20 per day. If you are NOT entitled to 15 hours free the cost is £50 per day for a full time place or £30 per day for a part time place.

Hot lunch is at a cost of £2.15 per day – please note this is not included in the cost of nursery fees.
