**Polytheistic/polytheism** – the belief in more than one god/goddess

**Frieze** – a horizontal band of decoration (either painting or sculpture). Friezes are found on the wall near the ceiling.

**Mount Olympus** – the highest mountain in Greece. Thought to be the home of the gods and goddesses in Ancient Greek mythology.
