

Jean-Michel Basquiat

Born in New York in 1960, Basquiat began doing street art like Paul Klee, then moved towards painting and drawing. With an interest in heroes, heritage and how people lived differently. Basquiat merged mediums, symbols and poetry, with opposite subjects like inside/out and rich/poor.

For this activity you will need: Paper, felt tip pens and oil pastels.

Lets start with the shape of our rabbit!

To make this artwork quicker we'll be using felt tip pens, then oil pastels. Alternatively you could do this part with paints and wait for it to dry...

 \rightarrow Using felt tips pens sketch the body shape of the rabbit.



 \rightarrow Next, the four bending legs. Then the face and big ears!

 \rightarrow Finally, if it's a red rabbit colour the outside red. You could chose a different colour if you like or even a mix!
