

## Eric Carle

Born in 1929, Carle is an American writer and illustrator, known for his most famous book The Very Hungry Caterpillar. In total he has illustrated more than 80 books!

For this activity you will need:

Pt. 1: 2 x Plain Paper, Water Colour Paints, Paint Brush and a cup of water.

Pt. 2 + 3: Pencil, Scissors, Glue



Let's begin by filling  $\rightarrow$  Use lots of water a whole page with colours to use for our seahorse! Have your paints, brush and cup of water ready.

Now clean and tidy away your brush, cup and paints.








Are your papers dry? If so, let's draw and cut out a sea horse! Leave your background to the side for Part 3

 $\rightarrow$  Last of all, draw on any extra detail and leave to dry!




