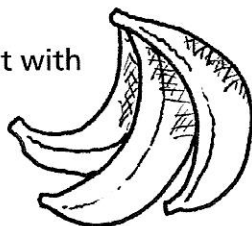

**banana (bananas)**

a banana is a long fruit with a thick, yellow skin.



**band (bands)**

**bank (banks)**

1. A bank is a place that looks after money and valuable things for people.

2. A bank is also the ground near the edge of a river, canal, or lake.

**bar (bars)**

a bar is a long, thin piece of wood or metal.

*The monkey put its hand through the bars of its cage.*

**bare (barer, barest)**

1. If part of someone's body is bare, it is not covered.

*Jenny came downstairs in her bare feet.*

2. A room or cupboard that is bare has nothing in it.

**bargain (bargains)**

a bargain is something that is worth more than you pay for it.

*I got a real bargain in the sale.*

**bark <sup>1</sup>**

bark is the hard covering round the trunk and branches of a tree.

**bark <sup>2</sup> (barking, barked)**

when dogs and foxes bark, they make a hard, loud sound.

**barn (barns)**

a barn is a large building on a farm, used to store things like hay.

**basket (baskets)**

a basket is for holding or carrying things. Baskets are made of strips of material like straw or thin wood.

**bat (bats)**

1. A bat is a piece of wood for hitting the ball in a game.



2. A bat is also an animal like a mouse with wings.

**bath (baths)**

a bath can be filled with water so that you can sit in it and wash yourself.

**bathroom (bathrooms)**

a room with a bath or shower.

**battery (batteries)**

a battery has electricity inside it. You put batteries in things like torches and radios to make them work.

*My watch needs a new battery.*
