WHAT IS DENSITY?

It is how we describe how much space something (an object or a liquid) takes up in relation to the amount of matter in that object or substance.

WHICH OBJECT IS HEAVIER?

Is the big pillow heavier than the smaller brick?.

If an object is light and takes up a lot of space it has a LOW density, like the pillow.



If an object is heavy and compact it has a HIGH density, like the brick.

REMEMBER: A big object is not always heavier than a smaller object.



WE KNOW THAT <u>OIL AND WATER</u>
<u>DON'T MIX</u>. IN OUR EXPERIMENT,
ADDING SALT CREATED MOVEMENT
BETWEEN THE OIL & WATER.

Oil is <u>less</u> dense than water so it floats on the top of water.
