### LEARN

#### Character

- In the top right corner of your page, draw a person. This is your main character.
- Give them a name
- In the top left corner of your page, write three adjectives that describe their appearance.
- Next, write 5 adjective that describe their personality.
- Draw a box below your character and, inside the box, write or draw what your character is doing.
- Draw a thought bubble from your character and fill it with how your character is feeling.
- Set a timer and spend 5minutes asking 'Why?' to everything on the page –this will help you to get to know your character really well.
