Brazen – bold/ without any shame

Crook – a dishonest person or a criminal

Hinges – a movable mechanism that connects a door to a frame (for example)

Conscientious – someone who does things well and puts a lot of effort into it

Stench – smell or odour (usually a nasty one)

Rational – logical/well reasoned

Decency – behaviour that is proper and accepted

- Model response Q2 “What does the word vandal mean?”

Thought process...”I am not sure what vandal means but I can work out the meaning of this word by looking at the text. Daddy Bear says “she is a vandal”. He complains throughout the text that the door has been smashed off its hinges, his wife’s chair has been broken, muddy footprints have been left on the stairs and the beds have been climbed on. Lots of things have been broken or messed about with so we can assume that a **vandal** is someone who destroys things that don’t belong to them.”
