**1. Who were the Olympic Games held in honour of?**

Zeus

**2. In Ancient Greece, women from which city state were predominantly interested in sport?**

Sparta

**3. Which events formed part of the Olympic Games?**

The long jump, horse and chariot racing, boxing and wrestling, javelin, running and discus.

**4. Were all women allowed to attend the Olympic Games?**

Unmarried girls were allowed to attend. Married women were not.

**5. With feuds between city states common, what precautions were put in place to ensure that everyone arrived in Olympia safely?**

Messengers announced a 'sacred truce' or a peace treaty. This temporarily called off any wars or disputes so that people could travel to Olympia safely.
