

Lesson 6: What is Vaisakhi?

Vaisakhi is a Sikh harvest festival that shows gratitude and thanks for the harvest of food and crops that year. It also involves prayers for future crops.

It also remembers the formation of the **Khalsa** – the community of Sikhs who help protect the religion and each other.

It is celebrated by Sikh people around the world in April each year.
