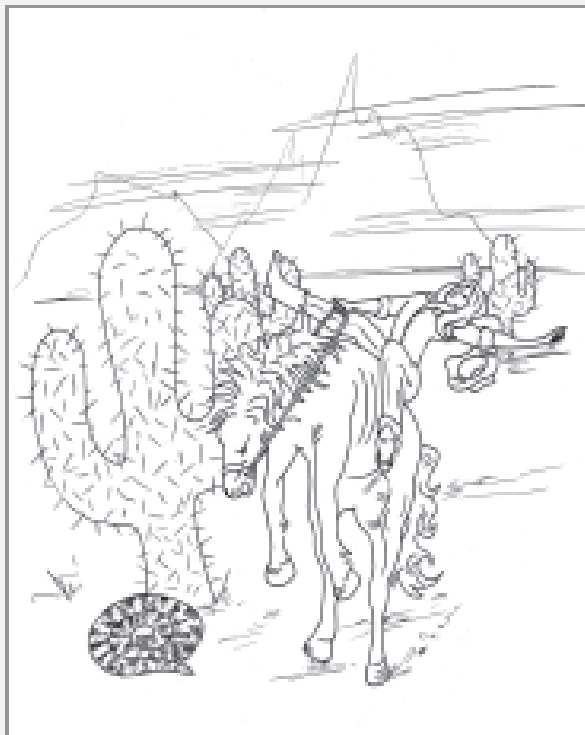


THE BATTLE OF MISTY MOUNTAIN
