How did you feel as a crew member at each stage of the journey?

5th December 1914:

Began the expedition -heading for the Sandwich Islands.

Example: Ecstatic, proud, nervous

May 1916:

Shackleton took the James Caird and a small crew in search of help

30th August 1916:

Shackleton rescues the remaining crew

8th August 1914:

Waved goodbye to loved ones and set sail from Plymouth to Buenos Aires

Jan 1915:

Reached the Weddell Sea and 700 miles of jigsaw like pack ice.

23rd December 1915:

Packed up Ocean Camp and set off in search for safer ice.

21st June 1915:

Celebrated Midwinter's Day with eating, singing and speeches.

November 1914:

Made final preparations at Grytviken whaling station.

February 1915:

Built a base camp for the pending winter as the Endurance was trapped in the ice.

29th February 1916:

Celebrated the leap year before escaping the ice and setting sail for Elephant Island

21st November 1915:

Crushed beyond repair, the Endurance finally sank

August 1916:

Shackleton and crew arrive at Stromness Whaling Station

January 1914:

Responded to a newspaper article and was invited to join The Endurance's crew.
