3-year-Olds – 30 Hours Free Eligibility

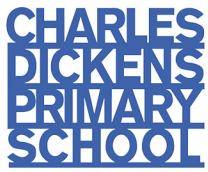
Early morning sessions are from 8 am to 9 am and cost of £5 per day which includes breakfast.
