VOCABULARY

Country: a nation with its own government

Capital (city): the administrative centre of a country

City: a large town

Union Jack: the national flag of the United Kingdom



LEARN

- Revisit learning from 'The United Kingdom' topic:

The four countries of the United Kingdom are **England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales**. Although the countries are much older, the United Kingdom has existed since 1801.

Each of the countries also has its own capital city: **London** in England, **Belfast** in Northern Ireland, **Edinburgh** in Scotland and **Cardiff** in Wales.

- The Union Jack is formed by combining the red and white crosses of St George, St Andrew, and St Patrick and retaining the blue ground of the flag of St Andrew
