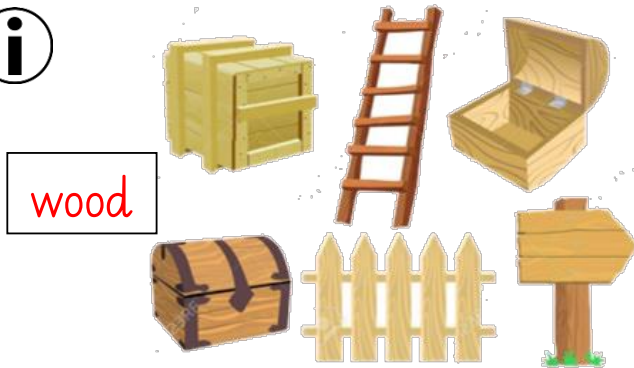
Fabric can be stretchy, squashy and can take any shape.

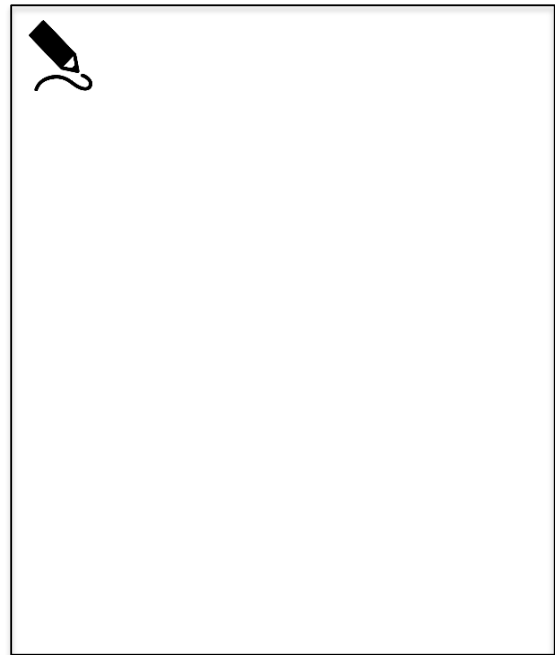
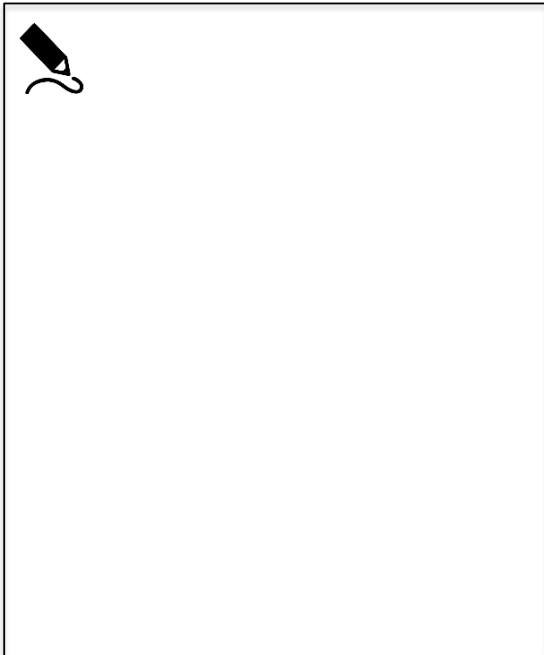
