## **WEEK COMMENCING 11th May**



**Blossoms**: The flowering part of a plant or tree that will form the seeds or fruit **Roots**: The part of a plant that grows downward and holds the plant in place

**Seed:** The part of a plant which can grow into a new plant **Bud:** A small part of a plant, that develops into a flower or leaf

Petal: brightly coloured leaves on a flower

Germination: The phase of plant growth when the seed begins to sprout
